SUMMARY

Pharmaceutical manufacturers must maintain rigorous plant operational processes many of which can be randomly spot checked by the FDA. Corporate Technologies (designed and implemented a BI system that provides instant visibility into manufacturing equipment maintenance, calibration, performance, scheduling, emergency activity, and the current and historical effectiveness of the different plant work teams. A further critical benefit is the generation of the necessary FDA reports, which in the past required a lot of manual work to assemble the data needed.

Problem	This global Pharma manufacturer needed a better process for assessing plant maintenance, calibration, and performance as well as reviewing maintenance scheduling, daily work completion performance and emergency activity. A critical associated need was to reduce the work required to respond to random FDA spot checks.
Solution	CTI was commissioned to design and implement a general purpose plant maintenance analytics system integrating data from the INFOR/EAM-CMMS application. This system needed to provide visibility into manufacturing equipment maintenance, calibration, performance, scheduling, and emergency activity. It was a requirement that it automatically provide the FDA reports, as well as present the current and historical effectiveness of the different plant work teams. The solution was implemented using Informatica ETL, IBM Netezza database, and the self-service plant activity reports and dashboards using SAP Business Objects technology.
